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




On 12th Jan 2024, Computer Science and Engineering department Organized Mahendra Alumni Interactive Lecture Series (MAILS) on "NATIONAL START-UP DAY". The Resource person of the event is Mr. S. SRI VIGNESHWAR, Tech Lead, iBirds Technologies, Bangalore & Mr. S. SRIRAM, Software Engineer, TCS, Bangalore. The session started by 10.30AM. The session was attended by more than 80 attendees including students and faculty of Computer Science and Engineering department.

They explained about the Models behind startups presenting as ventures are usually associated with design science. Design science uses design principles considered to be a coherent set of normative ideas and propositions to design and construct the company's backbone.

Also discussion about Lean start-up has also taken place in which Lean startup is a clear set of principles to create and design startups under limited resources and tremendous uncertainty to build their ventures more flexibly and at a lower cost. It is based on the idea that entrepreneurs can make their implicit assumptions about how their venture works explicit and empirically testing it. The empirical test is to de/validate these assumptions and to get an engaged understanding of the business model of the new ventures, and in doing so, the new ventures are created iteratively in a build–measure–learn loop. Hence, lean startup is a set of principles for entrepreneurial learning and business model design. More precisely, it is a set of design principles aimed for iteratively experiential learning under uncertainty in an engaged empirical manner.

The whole event was very energetic and successful. Students of Computer Science and department raised many doubts and queries. Also well Interacted with resource person.






### Report - Mehndi
