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



Micro plastics, tiny plastic particles, have been found in the food we consume and the air we breathe, raising health concerns. Students clearly stated about that Plastics take hundreds of years to decompose fully, contributing to the enduring nature of the problem. The motto behind its observation is spreading awareness among people about Ozone Layer depletion and searching for possible solutions to preserve it.



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

The chief guest started his inaugural address by thanking for the opportunity given and she addressed about the basic needs of Self Help Group that aims to minimize economic and social exclusion and spread the culture of monetary saving, solidarity, and teamwork by providing small endowments to individuals to set up their own small or micro-enterprises. She also delivered about how works on resolving conflicts via mutual discussions and collective leadership. She mentioned that self help group focuses on supporting the most vulnerable, particularly women-headed households, persons with disabilities and youth who do not have access to affordable financial resources. Small farmers, micro-business owners, crafts and small industries, families dependent on home income-generating projects, and street vendors are also part of the targeted group. to be used in research activities.

OUTCOME OF THE EVENT:

This helps in increasing strength of a group and can be useful in overcoming problems of water, sanitation, and toilets by them. The process of networking and linkages with Municipal Corporation, Government Offices, Banks, Corporators, Local leaders etc were also discussed. This can be used to solve their immediate problem of water and sanitation. Use of negotiation skills in getting their work done was also explained to the participants. Negotiation being a two way process in which two parties meet face to face to reach a mutually acceptable resolution of the issue was explained to them vis-avis mediation in which assistance of a neutral third party is sought.

The guest Speaker was started his speech about our farmlands have reduced to just a little over a hectare per household. The soil is depleted of its nutrients by overusing chemicals, and also wrong products. The chief guest also stated about the farmer seeks the less expensive versions of agrochemical substances, which are also of low quality. He also delivered about Agriculture stakeholders including farmers, agrochemicals and seeds companies, agricultural experts, researchers and academicians; and ministers and politicians are anxious to promote sustainable farming and the use of agrochemicals. He mentioned that Crop protection requires the judicious use of pesticides and agrochemical substances. Overusing branded products is one problem, but using low quality and spurious products makes the farming activity a non-starter. He stated that stakeholder's feel a legislation to address this issue is a big imperative. Among the policy suggestions is Sama Dama Danda Bheda, the ancient Indian philosopher Kautilya's statecraft policy to use conciliation as the first step; giving gifts or compensation in the second; force an trickery in the third and fourth as the only way to eradicate this evil.

OUTCOME OF THE EVENT:

This Program carry out farmer sensitisation and assistance programmes related to their products, which will include directions on usage, and the right, judicious mix of substances, keeping in mind crop and soil varieties. Guest feels that local leaders among the farmers may be chosen on merit and empowered to use new technology and farming techniques. They, in turn, will become the change agents in their areas.


